INSTRUCTIONS

Individuals working in the cleaning and maintenance industry pursuing continuing education at the ISSA sponsored University of Industrial Distribution (UID) are eligible to apply for an ISSA Foundation UID Scholarship. This scholarship award shall be in an amount equal to the tuition charged to attend the UID program (tuition is \$995 for ISSA members).
