Sample National Cleaning Week Proclamation

WHEREAS: Cleaning and disinfection are an investment in protecting human health and safety;

WHEREAS: The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention stresses the importance of properly cleaning and disinfecting to protect against SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19, and other infectious diseases;

WHEREAS: ISSA–The Worldwide Cleaning Industry Association found that routine cleaning and disinfection reduces the number of surfaces contaminated by viruses by 62% and thereby significantly reduces the rate of transmission of infectious diseases;

WHEREAS: Manufacturers and distributors have worked 24/7 to produce and deliver critical cleaning and hygiene products throughout the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS: Essential front-line cleaning professionals have worked tirelessly to combat the spread of COVID-19 since the onset of this pandemic; and
